**Maj BEA Pascoe, Late Oxf & Bucks, 1 GJ, 1 RGJ, 1/2 GR, 4(V)RGJ**

Only one month after the diagnosis of acute myeloid leukemia Bryan Pascoe died on 16th March 2019.

Bryan was commissioned from Sandhurst on 15 Nov 1956 and joined his brother (General Sir Robert Pascoe) in 1 Oxf Bucks in Cyprus during the operational tour against EOKA. Later he was a Platoon Commander in Training Company at Winchester and he became Adjutant of 1 RGJ in Berlin during David House's time in command. Bryan also spent over two years on secondment to 1st/2nd Gurkhas (1962-64) and served in Singapore and Hong Kong where he was Signals Officer.

He retired from the Regular Army after nearly 10 years and was employed by Gallaghers' cigarette company where he became responsible for their marketing throughout North and South America. Finding that he was away from his family even more than he had been when in the Army Bryan once again changed direction and joined stockbrokers Cazenove where he went on to be a successful partner looking after the interests of Private Clients.

He maintained his many Regimental connections for another 12 years serving with 4 (V) Bn RGJ where he commanded F Company in Fulham.

Bryan was married to Tessa and they have three children, Edward, Sarah and Giles. There will be a cremation service for family members only and, at a date to be announced later, a Thanksgiving service will be held in Chichester Cathedral at which all his friends will be welcome.
