<p>Hari is an inspirational Gurkha veteran who lost both his legs above the knee whilst serving on operations in Afghanistan. This year, Hari is making an incredible bid to become the world's first double above the knee amputee to climb Mount Everest. In doing so his 'No legs No limits' expedition aims to positively change the global perception towards disability and deliver lasting change in his home country of Nepal. This is following a battle in the Supreme Courts of Nepal to overturn a ruling that precluded individuals with such disabilities from climbing the mountain.</p>
